Friends have been a leading voice for social justice for centuries. **Our voice in state government is critically important to many marginalized people**—including tens of thousands of state residents who have been enmeshed in the criminal justice system, who suffer economic hardship, and who are yet to endure the effects of our climate crisis. We work to give voice to those who cannot speak effectively for themselves.

The day begins with discussions of our priority issues, such as addressing **support for current and former prisoners, clean transportation, and preserving the safety net for those with limited resources**. We will then go to the Capitol Building by noon to bring our Quaker perspective as we meet with our individual legislators about these issues.

If you've never lobbied before, you are not alone! Perhaps you're hesitant about lobbying because you're unfamiliar with the issues. If so, Quaker Lobby Day is the place to learn. Registrants from the same legislative district will have the opportunity to visit as a delegation with appointments already made with their legislators.
